


7 - 4

Elimination Using Multiplication

Ex: $3x + 4y = 6$

$2(5x + 2y = -4)$



$$\begin{array}{r} \cancel{3x+4y=6} \\ -10x+\cancel{4y=-8} \\ \hline \cancel{-7x=14} \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 3(-2) + 4y = 6 \\ -\cancel{4y} + 4y = 6 \\ +6 \qquad \qquad +6 \end{array}$$


$$x = -2$$

$$(-2, 3)$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \cancel{4} = 12 \\ \cancel{4} \qquad \qquad \qquad 4 \end{array}$$

$$y = 3$$

Ex: $4x - 3y = 12$
 $4(x + 2y = 14)$




$$\begin{array}{r} \cancel{4x} - 3y = 12 \\ - \cancel{4x} + 8y = 56 \\ \hline 11y = -44 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} x + 2(4) = 14 \\ x + 8 = 14 \\ \cancel{x} + \cancel{8} = 14 - 8 \\ x = 6 \end{array}$$

$$y = 4$$

$$(6, 4)$$

Ex: $\begin{cases} 2(3x + 4y = -25) \\ 3(2x - 3y = 6) \end{cases}$



$$\begin{array}{r} \cancel{6x} + 8y = -50 \\ - \cancel{6x} - 9y = 18 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$3x + 4(-4) = -25$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 3x - 16 = -25 \\ +16 \quad +16 \\ \hline \end{array}$$


$$\frac{\cancel{11}y}{\cancel{11}} = \frac{-68}{11}$$

$$\frac{\cancel{3}x}{\cancel{3}} = \frac{-9}{3}$$

$$y = -4 \quad \boxed{(-3, -4)}$$

$$x = -3$$

Ex: $\begin{cases} 3(4x + 3y = 8) \\ 4(3x - 5y = -23) \end{cases}$



$$\begin{array}{r} 12x + 9y = 24 \\ - 12x - 20y = -92 \\ \hline 29y = 116 \end{array}$$


$$\begin{array}{r} 4x + 3(4) = 8 \\ 4x + 12 = 8 \\ -12 \quad -12 \end{array}$$

$$\frac{29y}{29} = \frac{116}{29}$$

$$\frac{4x}{4} = \frac{-4}{4}$$

$$y = 4 \quad (-1, 4)$$

$$x = -1$$
